"I've never had an edger, so am a bit of a novice. Originally I thought the engine was undersized, since it kept dying on me. I relented and read the manual to find you need to start at a higher setting and make a few passes gradually digging deeper. I was trying to dig deep on the first pass on unbroken ground. Following this new advise I was able to edge beautifully to full depth in three passes with no more engine failure. Also make sure you start the engine in the highest setting each time or your in for a nasty grind. I am glad I have the 3yr protection, since I see working this thing pretty hard."

"This expensive edger arrived in the box, and required some assembly, but was relatively easy to do.

However, I found that the mechanism for adjusting the edger blade is very poorly designed.

I found it impossible to actually run this machine as the handle stands nearly vertical and you are

literally on top of the machine while attempting to push it along. This makes uneven surfaces nearly impossible to negotiate.

I finally got so frustrated with trying to run this expensive edger that I shut it down and examined it carefully. I found that that the tension spring that's supposed to be notched into the mechanism used to adjust the blade height was completely free to wander up and down the shaft of the wheel mechanism. It would appear that the spring is supposed to fit into the notch at the base to provide downward tension and keep the blade off the ground when it's not being used or for starting.

I could not get the spring to fit into this notch under any and all circumstances!

So…here I am, with an expensive piece of yard maintanence equipment that was sent to me with a flaw either in design or production and I am tempted now to ask for my money to be returned such that I can put this toward what appears to be a much better designed edger: the Craftsman 5.0 ft/lb gas edger. This design is similar to the edger that I purchased 15 years ago from Sears and it worked fine until recently."
